

Ten Day Itinerary - Bahamas



DAY 1- MARSH HARBOUR (BASE) TO GREAT GUANA CAY

- Travel north to Settlement Harbour, **Great Guana Cay** and enjoy lunch at Nippers Beach Bar & Grill
 - At Nippers, explore the Atlantic beach and snorkel along the coral reefs
 - Anchor in Fisher's Bay and have dinner at Grabbas with a gorgeous sunset view



DAY 2 – GREAT GUANA CAY TO NO NAME CAY THEN GREEN TURTLE CAY

- Travel north to **No Name Cay** (Day Anchorage only)
 - Feed the swimming pigs

- Have lunch and refreshments at Big O's Bar & Grill
- Then for the night, cruise north onto **Green Turtle Cay**
 - Head to White Sound and dock or moor at the Green Turtle Club Marina
 - Have dinner at the Green Turtle Club or the Bluff House
- **Green Turtle Cay** is a quaint, quiet town during the day where you can also enjoy a meal and something cool to drink. Some places to visit with your dinghy while there is Pineapples or Sundowners.



DAY 3 – MANJACK AND CRAB CAY

- Travel further north to **Manjack Cay and Crab Cay**.
 - Anchor on the northwest bay (Nunjack Bay)
 - Dinghy to the beach and feed the sharks and stingrays
 - Enjoy a tranquil dinghy ride through the mangrove nurseries on the southern end of the island
 - Explore Crab Cay and even Fiddle Cay
 - Cook dinner on the boat and enjoy the peaceful solitude of the uninhabited island



DAY 4 – MANJACK CAY TO TREASURE CAY

- Head south to **Treasure Cay**, pass through the Whale Cay Channel and make your way into Treasure Cay's southern harbour to catch a mooring ball.
- Have a truly Bahamian lunch at Florence Café.
- Walk across the island to the 3-mile-long crescent beach, named one of the top ten beaches in the world by National Geographic.
- Have dinner at the Bahama Beach Club, enjoy drinks and lounge by the pool.



DAY 5 – TREASURE CAY TO HOPE TOWN

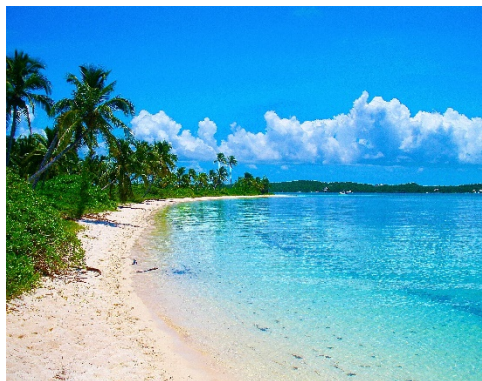
- Travel south to **Hope Town** and grab a mooring ball in the harbour or dock at Hope Town Inn & Marina.
 - Visit the 130-year-old Elbow Cay Lighthouse.
 - Dinghy across the harbour to Hope Town Settlement. You can rent a bicycle or golf cart and explore the island.

- Visit Hopetown Canvas, a charming little canvas shop with locally hand-crafted bags and handmade Bahamian jewelry.
- Have lunch at Firefly, Abaco Inn, or On Da Beach Bar & Grill.
- Return to Hope Town Inn & Marina and have dinner at their restaurant.



DAY 6 – HOPE TOWN TO TAHITI BEACH

- Head south to anchor at **Tahiti Beach**
 - Get lunch and drinks from the Thirsty Cuda, a floating bar anchored right off the beach. Swim lazily in the shallow waters and soak up the sun.
 - Stay anchored here overnight and enjoy dinner on the boat or dinghy to White Sound harbour and have dinner at Abaco Inn.



DAY 7 – TAHITI BEACH TO TILLOO CAY AND THEN PELICAN CAY

- Take the vessel around the western aspect of Lubbers Quarters and anchor on the northern side of the Tilloo Bank.
 - Explore the shallow sand bars of the Tilloo Bank.
 - Have lunch on the beach.
 - Take a dinghy ride through the Tilloo Pond.
 - Walk across the island to the Atlantic side and snorkel along the coral reef on the shore.
- Take the vessel further south around Tilloo Bank and anchor near Sandy Cay in the southern aspect of the bay.
 - Sandy Cay, aka Shell Island, is a great place for shelling.
 - Snorkel along the coral gardens offshore.
 - Dinghy to the **Pelican Cays** and explore the islands.
 - Enjoy dinner aboard the vessel with a sunset view.



DAY 8 – PELICAN CAYS TO LITTLE HARBOUR

- Travel further south to **Little Harbour**. The harbour is tide sensitive so if tide allows, catch a mooring ball in the harbour. Another option for anchorage lays to the west of Tom Curry Point in the Bight of Old Robinson.

- Enjoy lunch and drinks at Pete's Pub.
- Swim in the shallow bay.
- Visit Pete's Pub's gallery- The Johnston Art Foundry- and admire the breathtaking bronze sculptures.



DAY 9 – LITTLE HARBOUR TO MAN-O-WAR

- Head north to **Man-O-War Cay** and catch a mooring ball in the eastern harbour or anchor on the northwest side of Dickies Cay.
 - Dinghy into the main settlement and explore the quaint, charming island.
 - Visit the Man-O-War Coffee Shop and Museum. Grab a coffee and brunch and venture through the museum's relics of the past.
 - Check out the Man-O-War Sail Shop where you have many choices of beautiful handmade sail bags.
 - Stop by the world-famous Albury Brother's Boat Building site.
 - Walk across the island to the beach on the Atlantic coast and enjoy a swim in the ocean.
 - Provision at Man-O-War Grocery and make dinner aboard your yacht.



DAY 10 – MAN-O-WAR TO MARSH HARBOUR (BASE)

- Enjoy the tranquil morning journey back to the Marsh Harbour base at Boat Harbour.
- Be sure to arrive with enough time to refuel, debrief and pack up your belongings before 10am.
